

STANDARD 6 Curriculum

This is an outline of the components to include in your application and binder for Standard 6.

1. Documentation (such as a picture of the cover of a published curriculum or proof of payment) of an evidence-based curriculum including title, publication date
 - a. If self-created, must have references to reflect current evidence and practice guidelines, and cultural appropriateness for population served
 - b. A curriculum is defined by having 4 components and is a framework; individual instructor style and examples may vary:
 - i. Evidence-based content
 - ii. Learning objectives
 - iii. Method of Delivery that uses problem-solving approaches, is participant-centric and involves active learning
 - iv. Method for evaluating learning
 - c. The curriculum is a reference for the team
 - i. Allows consistent messages to be delivered no matter who is teaching
 - ii. Provides “lesson plan” for all members of team, in case primary instructor is out
 - d. Content of curriculum should cover the following areas at a minimum (see www.diabeteseducator.org for more detail on the AADE7™ Self-Care Behaviors):
 - i. Pathophysiology and treatment options
 - ii. Healthy eating
 - iii. Being Active
 - iv. Medication usage
 - v. Monitoring, including pattern management, interpretation of patient-generated health data
 - vi. Preventing, detecting, and treating acute complications
 1. Hypoglycemia
 2. Hyperglycemia
 3. DKA
 4. Sick days
 5. Severe weather or crisis supply management/disaster preparedness
 - vii. Preventing, detecting, and treating chronic complications
 1. Immunizations
 2. Eye
 3. Foot
 4. Dental
 5. Kidneys
 - viii. Healthy coping
 - ix. Problem solving
