<b>Patient enrolled in Medicare</b>	<ol style="list-style-type: none"> <li>1. Consider insurance plan formulary alternative</li> <li>2. Consider use of Manufacturer PAP if conditions met</li> <li>3. Consider use of Human insulin product</li> </ol>
<b>Patient with private insurance</b>	<ol style="list-style-type: none"> <li>1. Consider insurance plan formulary alternative</li> <li>2. Consider Manufacturer PAP if conditions met</li> <li>3. Consider cost savings programs</li> <li>4. Discount card programs (Pay close attention to max savings with each card)</li> <li>5. Consider use of Human insulin product</li> </ol>
<b>Patient with Medicaid</b>	<ol style="list-style-type: none"> <li>1. Consider insurance plan formulary alternatives</li> <li>2. Consider prior approval process</li> </ol>
<b>Patient with no insurance</b>	<ol style="list-style-type: none"> <li>1. Consider manufacturer PAP if conditions met</li> <li>2. Consider online coupon programs</li> <li>3. Consider referral to site that offers Pharmacy with 340b status/HRSA registration</li> <li>4. Consider use of Human insulin product</li> </ol>
